

# NEW 2008 RESPIRATORY PROTECTION REGULATIONS

On January 1, 2008 new California regulations (Title 3 California Code of Regulations, Section 6739) for respiratory protection went into effect. These new regulations require employers to have a complete respiratory protection program in place. The program includes a medical examination, respirator fit-testing, training, program evaluation and record keeping.

## Filter Basics:

FILTER TYPE	PRODUCT TYPE	FILTER LIFETIME
N95	Water base products	24 hour workday
P95	Oil based products	24 hour workday
R95	Both oil and water based products	8 hour workday
