### Dow AgroSciences offers a support program to reduce applicator costs for equipment that is purchased and used exclusively with Dow AgroSciences products.

This program allows for rebates on product purchases when proof of equipment purchases is also provided. The following section outlines the incentives available:

The Continuum Equipment Support Program is designed to supplement equipment costs incurred by contractors or end users when setting up for Continuum Prescription Control and Container Management System.

End users and contractors who purchase Dow AgroSciences products and approved equipment (such as pumps, couplings, and/or hoses) and provide invoices substantiating both equipment and product purchases will be eligible for a \$4.00 per gallon rebate based on the participating products listed in the table below. These Dow AgroSciences products must be invoiced and used between **September 1, 2009 and August 31, 2010**. Invoices must accompany completed claim forms. EDI-reported sales from the Distributor(s) will be used to verify product purchase information. Maximum rebate value will not exceed \$5,000.00. # Program Rules

1. Program payment will be calculated on product invoiced and used September 1, 2009 through August 31, 2010.
2. Program payment will be based on submitted invoices of Dow AgroSciences IVM product purchases and Continuum™ equipment. EDI reported sales information from the Distributor(s) will be used to verify submitted product purchase information.
3. Payment of this program will be to the owner (end-user or contractor) of the contract mix equipment. To receive payment, user must submit a **completed** Claim Form and **appropriate** invoice documentation for the product purchases (from previous pages) made during the program year, as well as proof of purchase for equipment to be utilized with these products. Claims should be sent to Dow AgroSciences Program Headquarters by **November 30, 2010**. The invoice must clearly display user name, address, city, state, zip code, product purchased, quantity purchased, invoice date, invoice number, and dealer purchased from. To be considered valid, invoice documentation for equipment purchase must contain user name, address, city, state, zip code, equipment description, quantity purchased, purchase price, invoice date, and invoice number.
4. Forms submitted *without* proper tax information will not be paid until the necessary information is received.
5. Program payments will be mailed approximately the fourth week of November 2010. No product compensations will be allowed.
6. Dow AgroSciences will not issue a check below \$500.00 for this program.
7. Maximum one-time payment for program earnings is \$5,000.00.
8. In the event a contractor/end-user is owned or controlled by a Distributor customer of Dow AgroSciences and/or its affiliates, program payment will be made only when the Distributor customer has met the purchase payment obligations to Dow AgroSciences and/or its affiliates.
9. Dow AgroSciences reserves the right to audit any or all parts of this program.
10. All payments will be made as calculated by Dow AgroSciences. All decisions made by Dow AgroSciences with respect to program administration, including calculating program payments, shall be final and binding.
11. Any false or fraudulent reports submitted to Dow AgroSciences may result in the forfeiture of all payments under this program.
12. Participation in this program is subject to any terms, conditions and procedures that Dow AgroSciences may, at its discretion, adopt from time to time. Dow AgroSciences reserves the right to modify or terminate this program any time without notice.
