Pro-Cone Multi-use Professional Wildlife Excluder



The Pro-Cone was designed as an exclusion device to allow bats, small birds and small rodents (mice, rats, chipmunks, flying squirrels, red squirrels) to leave a structure, while preventing them from re-entering upon their return. The Pro-Cone looks professional and is a great time saver. It can be reused.



For Bat exclusion, do a "Bat Watch" at dawn or dusk, to determine best points of bat entry/exit on a structure. Determine number of bats entering/exiting at an entry/exit point. For colonies with 20 or more bats use multiple cones for best result.

It is imperative to "bat proof" and/or "rodent-proof" all inactive areas of a structure before installing cones, in order to prevent the animals from relocating to another area of the structure. We suggest using wire mesh with expandable foam or silicone caulk to close any open areas.

For entry/exit points larger than a cone opening, use more than one cone, putting them side by side.

To fasten cones, use 3/8" staples, 1" screws or silicone to attach base of cone over the opening that animals are using to leave a structure. Install at a downward angle for bats and birds, and straight out at least 1 foot above ground for small rodents. Seal with copper mesh, poly-foam, silicone or foam backer rod around the sides of the base.

Important Tips:

- Leave cones in place for a minimum of 3-5 days to ensure the animals have completely vacated the structure. Once you are certain all the animals are gone remove the cones and seal the opening.
- <u>DO NOT</u> remove bats during their birthing cycles. This will result in babies being trapped inside. Contact your local or state wildlife agency for more information regarding bat birthing cycle in your area.
- Never handle bats or other wildlife.
