Nitrogen release is by osmosis. Loss of nitrogen from high amount of irrigation associated with new plantings is greatly reduced. Release is unaffected by varying amounts of soil moisture, microbes or pH levels.

Contains sulfate of potash to help manage chloride levels.

TURFGRASS OVERSEEDING: Broadcast 8 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. (350 lbs. per acre).

GROUNDCOVER: Broadcast 5 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. (½ lb. per 100 sq. ft.).

SHRUBS & EVERGREENS: Sprinkle ½ cup evenly around dripline of plant and work into top 1 inch of soil.

TREES: Apply ½ lb. per 1 inch of trunk diameter. Distribute evenly under branches out to dripline.

NOTE: Liquid measuring cups hold approximately 8 oz. of dry granular fertilizer. Example: an 8 oz. (1 cup) measuring cup holds approximately 8 oz. (1/2 lb.) of dry granular fertilizer.
