Approximately 150 to 200 sq. ft. Stain Delete can be diluted to 1 to 1 with water. For heavy stains use Stain Delete full strength. Apply Stain Delete to surfaces with sprayer or roller. Always rinse treated surface immediately after use. **FOR CLEANING CONCRETE, STUCCO, CEMENT, TILE, WOOD, PLASTIC AND PAINTED SURFACES:** Apply Stain Delete to dry surface, use enough product to wet surface thoroughly (slight application will not allow product to penetrate properly). Allow 3 to 5 minutes contact time, then rinse surface thoroughly with water. **DO NOT LET PRODUCT DRY ON SURFACE PRIOR TO RINSING!**
