It's long lasting, reducing the need for reapplication. When applied in late summer, early fall or winter, it provides herbaceous weed control into the following spring. It's also easy to mix and use, even after wind and rain delays.

Application tips

- For best results, apply after weeds have emerged and are actively growing
- To control difficult hardwood brush and vines, apply as a foliar spray during the normal growing season, before defoliation in the Fall
- Tank mix with Glyphosate, Imazapyr, or Velpar® DF VU for increased control
- Apply in the northeast to control Rubus and other tough brush species
- Apply in the southeast to control Sericea Lespedeza, Vetch, Bahiagrass and more

Application and use

- Oust Extra is a dispersible granule that is mixed in water and applied as a spray
- Controls annual and perennial weeds and brush growing in conifer plantations and non-crop sites
- It is labeled for use with:
 - Loblolly and Slash Pines
 - Black Spruce
 - Red Pine
 - Douglas Fir
 - And more
- As a spray – apply using ground equipment or helicopter
- On impregnated fertilizer – apply using ground equipment or by air
